

## **DIRECTIONS for Crew – Cook’s Tour- May – Base Woodford Pool**

***NB Take care on gravel roads driving at speed can be risky***

### **80 km CREW**

Check your speedo reading on the odometer. Follow to the end of Peterson Rd and turn left into Langer St and take the next turn left into Nicklaus St. This will curve around to meet with George St where you again turn left and a few hundred metres along there is a right turn into Golf Course Rd. Follow this to the end and it goes to the right and becomes the gravel road, Beerburum-Woodford Rd. About 6 km from the pool you should see a mango tree on the right. **Checkpoint 7 is a few hundred metres down the forestry road on the right**

On return 80 km crew will need to go past Chpt 7 and take the forestry road to the left about 800 metres past to get to **Chpt 8**. This will take you to Raaen Rd ( bitumen ). Turn left and go about 1 km and turn right onto McConnell Rd. Park about 400 metres from Chpt 8 and walk the rest of the way if you wish to go to the checkpoint.

From the mango tree continue following the gravel Woodford-Beerburum Rd for just over 4.5km and take a left turn onto the gravel road which is Woodford-Lookout Rd. ( Beerburum-Woodford Rd will become bitumen here and go to the right )

**Checkpoint 6** is a few hundred metres along here, but meet your runner at the junction of the two roads. Do not park at the checkpoint.

Follow Woodford-Lookout Rd for about 3 km and you will see a gravel road ( Connection Rd ) going off to the left. Just ahead is the LOOKOUT , **it is not manned for 80km in May but you could see your runner here.** The LOOKOUT has toilets.

Follow past the LOOKOUT on bitumen road and turn right at the T junction at the bottom of the hill onto Old Gympie Rd. Less than a kilometre along a forestry road will cross this road. This is **Checkpoint 4a**. Do not stop at this checkpoint This checkpoint is manned for the 80km in May to watch them across a bitumen road.

Follow Old Gympie Rd and turn left at the junction with Beerburum- Woodford Rd. You will come to a T junction after a few kms. Turn left and about 500 metres along you will be at Beerburum State School which is next to **Checkpoint 2 in Parrot Park**. Parrot Park has a water tap and a toilet. Park in the parking bays in front of the school. This checkpoint is manned for the 80km in May. From about 2.30am

To get to **the Lookout** retrace your steps to Woodford-Beerburum Rd, turn right into this road and go straight ahead on the bitumen and turn right into Old Gympie Rd ( first bitumen turn on the right ). Follow Old Gympie Rd to the north and turn left onto the Lookout Rd and follow to the lookout.

To get to **Checkpoint 6** follow the gravel road past the lookout for about 3km to Beerburum-Woodford Rd. and meet your runner here.

To get to **Checkpoint 8** turn right into Beerburum-Woodford Rd and keep following B-W Rd west to the Mango tree and Checkpoint 7. As stated earlier follow past Chpt 7 for about 800 metres and take the forestry road to the left to get you to Raaen Rd.

On leaving Checkpoint 8 follow Raaen Rd ( bitumen ) all the way to the D’Aguilat Highway and turn right to get you back to Woodford and the Pool in Peterson Rd.

**50 km CREW – DO NOT GO TO CHPT 6** – You can get to Chpt 8 by following the D’Aguilar Highway for about a kilometre past D’Aguilar and then turn left onto Raaen Rd and follow to McConnell Rd ( the first gravel road on your right ). You must not drive right up to Chpt 8 but park about 400 metres from it and walk to it or just wait for your runner there ( they would need to cover just under 20k before seeing you again if you wait there ).

**11 and 30 km Entrants are not allowed a crew.**
