

ACCOMMODATION/ TRANSPORT GH 100

ACCOMMODATION in Caboolture:

This town is closer and easier to get to than those venues in the right hand column on the Accommodation page

There are four large motels in Caboolture within a kilometre of the railway station. Three of these are on Lower King Street which goes from the railway line east to the main Highway. Caboolture is about 15km from Beerburrum which is the base for the GH 100.

TRANSPORT:

SUNAIR runs a shuttle service on an hourly basis between the airport and Glasshouse and further north to Sunshine Coast. Drop off points are on the main highway only at the Mobil Service Station near Wild Horse Mt for GLASSHOUSE and at the BP Service Station near Morayfield for CABOOLTURE. Cost is around \$30 but you need to check.

RAILWAY:

From the airport a taxi can be taken to Toombul Station which is on the Caboolture Line or the Airtrain will take you to Eagle Junction which is on the Caboolture Line. Trains are fairly regular to Caboolture but from there north to Beerburrum and Glasshouse they are less regular. I think they use buses from Caboolture at times.
